SportsReach Football League Emergency action procedure

In case of an emergency or serious injury, requiring the attendance of the emergency services, managers are required to have completed this form and have it within at least both the first aid kit and home dressing room, in order to ensure that any emergency can be dealt with quickly and smoothly, whilst ensuring the emergency services attend the correct location. Managers are also required to ensure that players are aware of this form in case of an emergency, especially if it involves the manager.
