FRANCE

"SportsReach came to France for one week as they have been faithfully coming for the past 16 years. They were a huge blessing to our local ministries as well as to the local teams they have been playing for years now.

Using football as a bridge for the gospel message into the lives of youth and adults who would otherwise not have the opportunity to hear.

We hosted for the first time a three day English and football school for the children of our local community here in Saint Albain, giving us the opportunity to build new relationships and casually share and live out the Gospel message with children who would otherwise have minimal access to the Gospel. The youth and parents had a blast and are eager to have SportsReach back next year!

We organized football games, had a barbecue and spent time with a group of migrants from all around the world (Chad, Mongolia, Albania, Guinea, Libya, Syria, Sierra Leone...) who are stuck in hotels in the city of Macon, waiting on their papers. Will Marsden and others from SportsReach eagerly shared the Gospel in English and through translation (French & Arabic)! A few men seemingly took steps of faith through prayer while others accepted to download a Bible app on their phone in their language.

SportsReach played against 4 local teams that they have been faithfully playing for years now, what really struck me was the enthusiasm SportsReach teammates had for praying for the teams and for sharing the gospel with them! The gospel was shared through "football sermons" with a content which was accessible and engaging to crowds much more accustomed to watching Premier league football then going to a church service.
