<u>Myanmar</u>

This was my fourth visit to Myanmar, and what a great time it was! It was a blessing to be able to take our eldest two daughters with us, Jen and Grace. Whilst there we coached football and netball most days with the children in Wyresdale Children's Home and with local villagers. Then we shared the shared the Gospel with them through drama, Bible stories and illustrations, while Ginzi translated. It was fantastic to hear that some of the local village children we shared with in 2018 had become Christians and got baptised! God is definitely at work in Burma!



We were privileged to be able to give quality kit to the children in the Home, and also to an U14's team who came asking to play a match against the boys from the Home. This was probably the highlight of the trip for me! We transported both teams to an army camp which had a full size grass pitch, and played an 11aside match which the Wyresdale Childrens' Home team won. Then all the children, including the U14 team who would be mostly Buddhist, sat and listened as we shared Jesus with them. You could have heard a pin drop, they were fixed on my every word. Please pray for these lads to open their hearts to Jesus. And then there was more! While the two lads' teams where transported back, we played football with the girls and younger children (who had already played an hour's netball with Jen!) while we waited for the truck to return. We played until well after dark, then formed a big circle and started singing and praising God together...this continued during the 30 minute truck journey...at the top of our voices! What a day that was! Please continue to pray for the work in Myanmar, as we have been asked to return to the Delta region for more children' work, and also to head north up to the Putao region to work amongst the youth. God is GOOD! *Sue*

It was such a privilege to visit Wyresdale Children's Home in Myanmar, on my first trip to Asia! I loved seeing the children enjoy themselves, throwing themselves into the football and netball, and showing their personalities when we played games with them. But a real highlight was hearing them sing, **their worship and praise to God** was so precious to witness. The children and workers there really are **a beacon of light amongst a community** and country that knows very little of Jesus, but the open doors we encountered was amazing. One day we had opportunity to visit the **delta region**, a 4 hour mini-bus ride, followed by over an hour on a little boat down the river, arriving in what felt like a **completely different world**, to meet a community who have suffered real hardship, but it is amazing to see how **God is at work** in their village and in their hearts.

Praise God for the open doors into schools!! Only God could give us so many chances to share the Good News of our Saviour.

Before Christmas, Ruth & I went into St. John's Primary School at Silverdale and completed our first 'Walk Through The Bible' course with the year 5 & 6's. Some comments from the children at the end of the 5 weeks – 'please come again soon'...'I don't go to church but I've loved doing WTTB with you and I've learnt so much'.

We are currently in Halton St. Wilfred's & Arkholme CE Primary School with WTTB, as well as Caton St. Paul's doing football, netball and RE.
